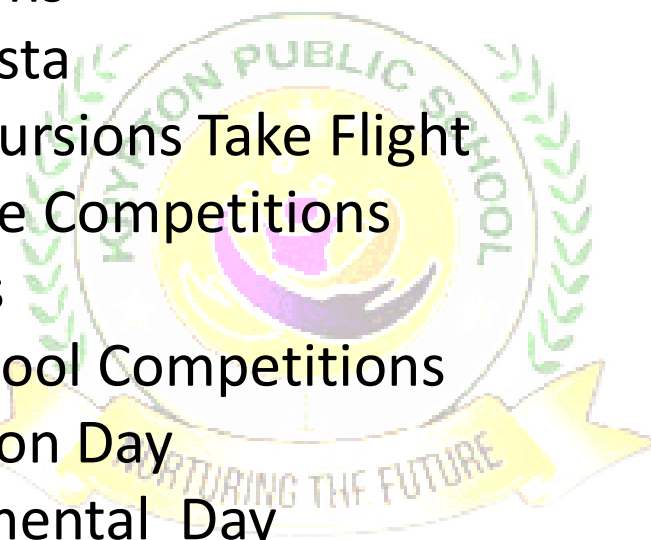

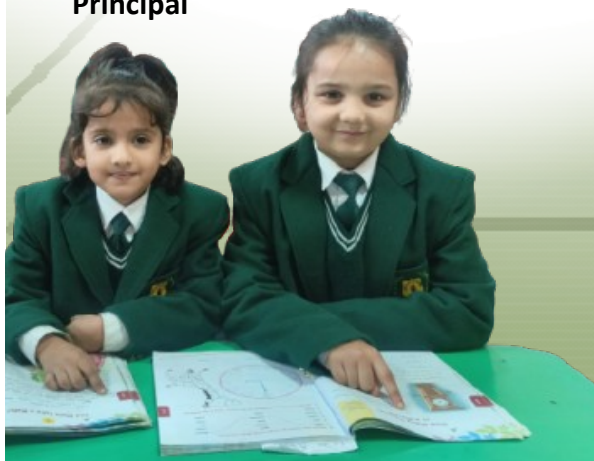

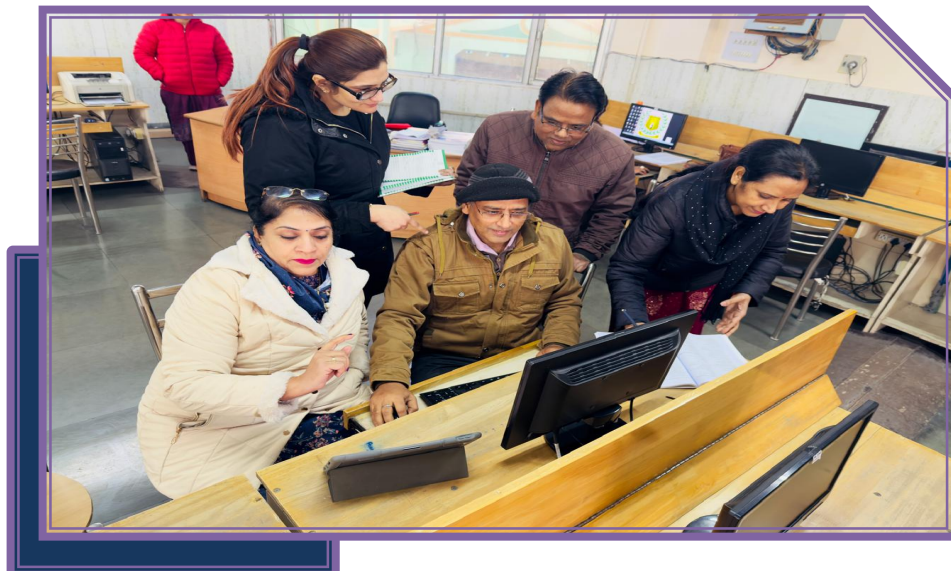

Let's read an inclusive, inspiring Interview of Kumar Ranvijay Singh (SP City) taken by Simar Raheja and Gaurang of class XI.



Student, what inspires you to join the police force, and what has kept you motivated throughout your career?

SP city: I got there through UP PCS. My father was in army. So I had always love for the uniform. I think the passion of wearing that uniform has taken me on a long journey. Somewhere I found that people were not treated, kindly whenever they used to come for their complaints. I have taken a pledge that I would definitely bring some improvements.

Student: what challenges did you face while preparing for the services exam, and how did you overcome them?

Sp city: I am from a very small place from Bihar. I had my schooling from there only. I had to go on foot for almost 6 kms daily. It was not at all easy. I have faced many challenges from different fronts. For my higher studies, I went to Delhi University. I did my masters and my LLB. Of course there were so many challenges. It was not a simple or easy task coming from a village background.

Students, what advice would you give to students aspiring to join the police force or civil services?

SP city: I will always give advice to the students that if you are passionate enough to join the police force or civil services, and then always take care of three steps in your life, and that is passion, hard work and determination.

Student: what message do you have for students who may be tempted to drive across without license?

SP City: This is one thing which I always try to teach whenever I get a chance to go to any school. It's very unfortunate that if we go by the data, deaths due to accidents are more than the deaths due to crimes. It's really very pathetic to find miserable families in such a condition where we always get helpless.

Student: What was your experience as a student, did you interact with the police personnel during your schooling?

No, I did not have any formal interaction with the Police during my schooling. My father was in the army, so I was familiar with army culture. Once I was found in my village, some of the police personnel were very rude to the village people, where I felt very bad and thought if I had been given a chance to be on high position. I would definitely be changing the way and we will be interacting with others very nicely.

Student: What do you think is the most important rewarding part to being a police person?

SP City: Removing somebody's stress into happiness is one of the best parts in our profession where I believe that justice is the only way which has been able to eradicate all the distress of the victim. There is no other big reward, than of bringing a smile into somebody's face that I believe is the best award in one life. I believe that God has given me one of the wonderful opportunities of making me police personnel to bring happiness and justice to others, and I am really full of gratitude that what I believe is the best reward given by God to me.

Student: How do you manage the stress that comes with your demanding job?

SP City: very good question, no doubt our job becomes very stressful. The reason being that whosoever comes to us comes in most of the time comes in distress, listening to that person patiently and to understand the instant intensity of the fact becomes very important. Some of the time we have to listen to the person's complaints in late nights or early mornings, and for that, we might not have that time to take rest. So in that way, it becomes very stressful. To be away from the stress, I always meditate in the morning as I know that it's the nature of my job where there is no escapism, and I cannot ignore it as it is the nature of my job. So I have to go on with the same kind of things.

Student: Could you share an inspiring or memorable case you have worked on that had a positive impact on students of school?

SP City: Many of them, basically I've done lot of cases, but I would certainly try to tell you that when I was posted in Ghaziabad, so many complaints regarding the children they get disappeared. The parents they happen to come to Thana so some of the times it becomes very important to handle the case Very immediately, so I handled one of the missing children case. I lead one such of operation where different strategies have been made, so we are right to call the initiative to talk to my seniors and got the fortunate. I got support from them and we started our initiative to recover the disappeared children. Then during that process we happen to get back a guy who disappeared from he last five years and you can imagine the happiness and that feeling whatever we have given to his parents, so I really always grateful to God. I don't know from where I get this kind of energy and all the potential and it's all becomes very miraculously done, so I really sometimes do not believe that what's happening around. So while cracking those case by cracking this case that case, especially the operation had been taken now from throughout the state and it got an eye of media and everyone because it was one of a huge case which being cracked and then we happened to crack that human therapy case, and in that way, thousands of children were Taken back and 2015, data tells us that we could be able to recover almost 25,000 of the missing children, so my feeling was like I cannot even explain it, but I said that Ishwar Apne mujhe Insaan Banaya aur mujhe Yeh Sabkar Karen ki energy De I must thank my bosses and my SSP at that time, they all being very, very cooperative and this could become a huge success.

If you want to see that you can google it, you can Google on operation smile, Ranvijay Singh, Ghaziabad Police, so you'll be having all the details. I was documented. There is a small media which is also on YouTube on different platforms. You can always watch it.

Student: sir, what message would you like to give to the student?

SP City: I always tell the students to be Sanskari. Sanskari means to be possessed with all ethics and values. First of all let's be human. I request everyone to be human to have that benevolence and kindness in your mind and bring that patience to listen to each other, so that you can always bring a better society, so my core message to everyone is to respect your elders and help others. Love for your juniors, respect for your elders. , if you're having these ethics in your life, you will always be given a very respectful place in the society.

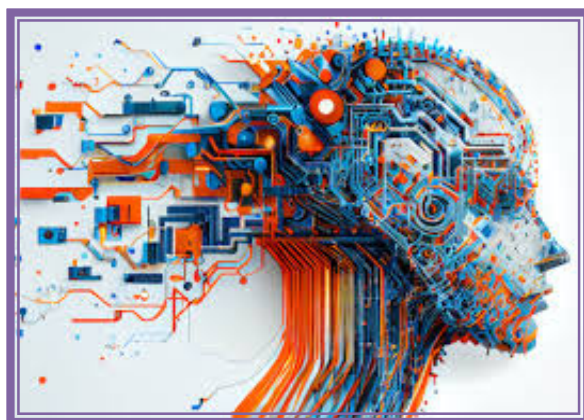

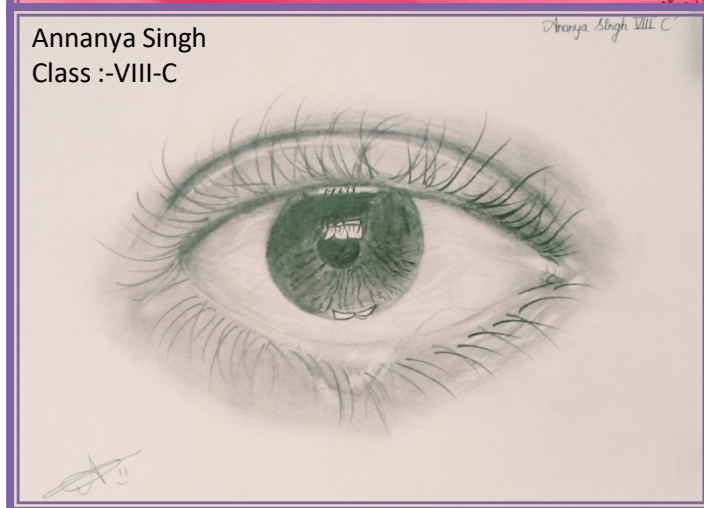


Snowfall

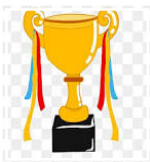
